## **I. ELIGIBILITY TO APPEAR FOR RESIDENTIAL DEGREE COLLEGE COMMON ENTRANCE TEST (RDC-CET) 2019**

- a) Students appeared for Senior Intermediate Examination in March/April-2019 conducted by the Board of Intermediate Education of Telangana or equivalent examination are **ONLY** eligible to appear for the test, subject to the other conditions.  
**The students appearing for the Intermediate instant examination in 2019 are not eligible for admission.** Hence they need not apply for the entrance test.
- b) The students should have passed the qualifying examination in **one and first attempt in IPE-March 2019** and secure 50% of marks on aggregate and 40% of marks in English subject. (There is a relaxation of 5% in case of SC/ST).
- c) For B.A., (HEP & HPE) all the students are eligible irrespective of subjects studied in Intermediate. But they have to take Entrance Test in **ENGLISH, HISTORY, ECONOMICS and CIVICS.**
- d) For B.Com., (General & Computers) students of CEC or any other group are eligible as per university norms. But they have to take the Entrance Test in **ENGLISH, ECONOMICS & COMMERCE.**
- e) For B.Sc., (MPC & MPCS) students of intermediate MPC, for B.Sc., (BZC) students of intermediate Bi.PC, are eligible to write examination.
- f) For B.Sc., (MSCS) (Maths, Statistics & Computer Science) Inter MEC & MPC students are eligible to write entrance examination.
- g) BC/SC/ST/EBC women students are eligible for admission.
- h) Annual Income of the Parents/Guardian shall not exceed Rs.1,50,000/- Rural areas and Rs.2,00,000/- in Urban Areas.

## **II. Scheme and Syllabus for the Common Entrance Test**

- ❖ The examination will be in one session of  $2^{1/2}$  hours duration in the subjects mentioned at above Table (Column 4).
- ❖ Examination will be conducted for 150 marks in Total. There will be three papers for 40 marks in each subject in addition to English paper for 30 Marks. English paper is common to all.
- ❖ For B.Com General & Computer courses the question paper will be in English, Economics & Commerce subjects 50 marks for each subject.
- ❖ Examination will be conducted on Intermediate syllabus (Board of Intermediate Education, Telangana, Hyderabad) for group subjects.
- ❖ Questions will be in both **English and Telugu media and in objective** type multiple choice questions. Answers should be marked in OMR answer sheet.
- ❖ There will be no negative marks for wrong answers.
- ❖ For correct results all the answered circles should be shaded fully & thickly in OMR answer sheet.

## **III. Reservation of Seats:**

- a) SC: 15%, ST: 5%, BC-A: 18%, BC-B: 26%, BC-C: 3%, BC-D: 18%, BC-E: 10%, EBC: 2% & Orphans: 3%.
- b) 3% of seats will be filled with differently abled persons within the category.

- c) In case there are any unfilled seats in any category, they will be filled with BC students. The carry forward principle in respect of BC students i.e., BC-A to BC-B, BC-B to BC-C, BC-C to BC-D, BC-D to BC-E, BC-E to BC-A and so on will be adopted.

#### **IV. HOW TO APPLY:**

- The candidate shall first go through the information bulletin carefully, available in the website, satisfy her eligibility for appearing the written test.
- The candidate after satisfying herself about the eligibility shall pay Rs.200/- through PAYMENT GATEWAY centres from **01-03-2019 to 08-04-2019** to enable to submit application online.
- At the PAYMENT GATEWAY centre, the candidate has to give the required preliminary data i.e., name, date of birth and mobile number.
- On receipt of the fee the candidate shall be issued a journal number with which she can proceed with submission of application online through the website [mjptbcwreis.cgg.gov.in](http://mjptbcwreis.cgg.gov.in) Issue of journal number does not mean that the candidate has completed the submission of application online. It is only a confirmation of the Fee received.
- Before filling of online application, the candidate has to fill up the model application form given in the Annexure.
- The candidate shall follow the procedure for submission of online application as given in the “Information Bulletin” and also as per the instructions provided online while filling up the online application. The candidate should be ready with passport size photograph (3.5 x 4.5 cms) before filling online application. The Photo should be scanned and uploaded along with the application form.
- **While filling the online application, the candidate has to opt the course.**
- On submission of application online, the candidate has to take a copy (print) of application form in which a reference number also be given. This reference No. is required to download the Hall Ticket. The copy of online application is to be preserved for further reference.
- For any mistakes/incorrect information, the candidate is solely held responsible. Hence they must take utmost care while filling the online application.
- The applications of the ineligible candidates will be rejected.
- The selected candidate should be able to produce the original certificates at the time of admission as a proof to the information furnished in the application.
- The selection of the candidate will be summarily rejected if they fail to submit the necessary documents at the time of admission.

#### **V. COURSES OFFERED**

The candidate is requested to choose any one of the Category of Course as per her eligibility in the qualifying examination i.e., Intermediate. Common counseling will be conducted for admission into MJPTBCW Residential Degree College for (WOMEN) Wargal, Siddipet district.

**NOTE:** 30 Marks English paper is common to all above course wise subjects mentioned above (Sl.No. 1 to 6 courses) and 50 marks English paper for B.Com. General & Computer courses (Sl.No. 7 & 8 courses).

#### **VI. Jurisdiction of Candidates**

- The candidate, who has studied in any of the educational institutions, located in any district of Telangana State are eligible.
- Private candidates should submit **Nativity Certificate** obtained from the MRO/Tahasildar. **Residence Certificate will not be accepted.**
- Candidates must be the residents and must have studied in **Telangana** only.
- The candidates must have appeared Intermediate or its equivalent exam in March/April-2019 in **single attempt** only are eligible. **Supplementary & Instant candidates are not eligible for admission.**

#### **VII. Issue of Hall Tickets:**

- Candidates can download their Hall Tickets from the website at [mjptbcwreis.cgg.gov.in](http://mjptbcwreis.cgg.gov.in) from **15-04-2019** onwards with the reference number allotted to them.
- Candidates have to download the hall tickets from the website only. No printed hall ticket shall be issued/posted to the candidate.
- Without hall ticket, no candidate will be allowed to appear for the examination.

#### **VIII. General Information:**

- Admissions are **only for Women** into RDC, WARGAL, Siddipet Dist.
- Mere appearing for the Entrance Test does not confer any right for admission. Applicants shall also fulfill other admission criteria stipulated by MJPTBCWREI Society, Hyderabad as the case may be.
- The administration reserves the right of changing the rules to be followed as per the directions of the Government and University from time to time.
- The candidates are personally held responsible for incorrect information in the application form.
- The Convener reserves the right to cancel the admission at any stage, if the particulars furnished by the candidate are found incorrect or against the rules of admission.
- The fee once paid will not be refunded.

#### **IX. SELECTION OF STUDENTS:**

Selection of students shall be made based on the following:

1) Merit in the Entrance Examination

2) Rule of reservation

3) Reservation under Special category

- In case of tie among the candidates with same marks in the entrance test, the order of the merit of the subjects in entrance examination as detailed below will be taken into consideration.

a) For B.Sc (MPC & MPCS) Maths, Physics & Chemistry

b) For B.Sc. (BZC) Botany, Zoology & Chemistry

c) For B.Sc. (MSCS) i) Maths, Physics & Chemistry for Inter MPC students

ii) Maths, Economics & Commerce for Inter MEC students

d) For B.A.(HEP & HPE) History, Economics & Civics

e) For B.Com (General & Computers) : Economics & Commerce

f) If the tie still persists, the higher marks secured by the candidate in English will be taken into consideration.

4) If the tie still persists, it will be decided by taking advanced age as criteria.

a) If still the tie persists, candidates belonging to the following communities (in that order) shall be given a higher rank:

a) ST

b) SC

c) BC (A)

d) BC (B)

e) BC (C)

f) BC (D)

g) BC (E) and

h) EBC
